Typical Use

Dulux Quick Drying Satin ia a tough, durable self-undercoating water-based satin finish particularly suitable for the decoration of interior and exterior woodwork as well as interior walls and ceilings if required.

It is quick drying and of low odour compared with conventional solvent-based paints, and does not yellow on ageing.

As with other water-based paints, do not use when the temperature is below 10°C or outside when ther is a likelyhood of rain, fog or frost as this will affect the drying process. Newly painted doors and windows should not be closed (tightly) until the paint is fully dry.

Before preparing any surface for painting, read the Safety, Health & Environmental information on page 2 about old lead-based paints.

Chemical Resistance:

Resistant to mild chemical fume attack but where there is heavy attack, e.g. actual contact with chemicals, specialist paint systems may be required.

Resistant to the levels of atmospheric humidity present in normal interior environments.

A typical set up for airless spray application would be a minimum working pressure on paint of 133 bars (2000lb/sq in) with a spray tip size 0.38mm (15

thou) and a spray tip angle 65°.

Practical CoverageA guide to the practical coverage which can be achieved under normal

conditions is 15m2 / litre

Cleaning Up After use, remove as much paint as possible from brushes before cleaning

with clean water.

Do not use or store in extremes of temperature and protect from frost.

SURFACE PREPARATION

When applying water-based paints to surfaces previously decorated with a conventional solvent-based paint, very thorough surface preparation will be necessary.

Surfaces must be clean, dry, free from all defective or poorly adhering material, dirt, grease, wax etc. New or bare surfaces should be primed with an appropriate **Dulux** primer.

Thoroughly rub down previously painted surfaces, using 'wet flatting' methods where possible, then wipe off with a damp, lint free cloth.

Avoid the inhalation of dust.

Wear a suitable face mask if dry sanding.

Treat any knots in wood with **Dulux** Knotting Solution. Any surface defects must be filled with a suitable filler.

SYSTEM INFORMATION

On new and bare wood apply one coat of **Dulux** Quick Drying Wood Primer Undercoat (two coats are recommended for exterior use).

On bare plaster and masonry surfaces apply a thinned coat of **Dulux** Quick Drying Satin.

The normal finishing process is 2 full coats of **Dulux** Quick Drying Satin. Where a strong colour change is involved, an extra coat may be requird.
